


# Connecting to Classweb from the CoB Lab


## WinSCP

1. Open the Start Menu and type “WinSCP”
2. Open the WinSCP application
3. Enter the following connection info, then click “Advanced”

- You may be prompted to Allow an “Unknown host key for classweb.acs.unt.edu”. If so, click “Yes” or “allow”
- Your site should now open in WinSCP, allowing you to drag and drop files

### FILE RESTRICTIONS

- File Size Limit: Individual files are limited to 2mb in size.
- File Type Restrictions: Executable files (.exe) are restricted.
